#### What is a Careers Website?

A Careers Website is either a section of a company's main corporate website or a stand-alone website, where available jobs and careers information is displayed. A Careers Website can feature a jobs area, or it may feature a jobs area plus lots of information & media designed to attract potential candidates into the company. The website is usually designed to reflect the corporate styling of the company & connected to your ATS system to allow quick job advertising & application management functionality.

## How is it used in practice?

A good Careers Website is intended to promote the ethos & brand identity of a company to attract talent. The Careers Website is intended to "sell the company" & to convert browsing candidates into applicants. The design of the website should let the candidate know who the company is before they even start to browse the available vacancies.
